COURSE INFORMATION

- **Course title:** International Approaches to Social Issues
 - We will focus on how different countries address common social issues, including child welfare, aging, and substance misuse.
 - Students and faculty from Italy, Czech Republic, Korea, Peru, and the US will attend together and learn from each other.
- **It is a three credit summer course** – students pay for the course like any other summer course.
- **It is a hybrid course** – the first part will be asynchronous online with some reflection assignments. The second half will be the 10 day course IN PERSON in Rome. BOTH parts are required.
- **Dates for the IN PERSON in Rome are:** July 10-19, 2024.
- **All classes will be in English.**
- **Registration opens on March 18th, 2024** for the course and it will be listed along with the other available summer courses. See below for the Rome registration. The deadline for course registration is April 15th, 2024.





TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

- All students are responsible for arranging their own transportation to and from Rome, including flights to Rome and then transportation to the Rome Center from the airport.
- There are taxis and Ubers that can take students to the Rome Center from the Rome airport, but the staff at the Rome Center can also arrange transportation if preferred. Students would pay for this option.



HOUSING/FOOD INFORMATION

- **Students stay at the CUA Rome Center.**
 - Registration link – Please complete this registration form in addition to registering for the summer course. This portal is now open.
 - The costs for staying at the Rome Center are estimated to be \$1000 per person for the room and breakfasts and dinners M-Th and Friday mornings for breakfast.
- **At the Rome Center**
 - There are singles, doubles, and triple rooms available. Students can choose, but may not be guaranteed their first choice. It will depend on availability.
 - Meals are included in the \$1000 payment . Breakfast and dinners are served and the staff can accommodate virtually every dietary restriction.
 - There are also refrigerators and microwaves available at all times.
- **The Rome Center is a fully gated campus** in Trastevere with 24 staff/security.
- **There is free laundry, Wifi, and printing.**
- It is walking distance to MANY restaurants, grocery stores, cafes/bars (which is a cafe in Italy), public transportation, parks, and easy access to the main sites of the city.
